Piccolo Master Class Competition Information

Competition Description:

The Piccolo Master Class Competition is open to all piccoloists. Two or three winners will be selected to play for our guest clinician, Patti Adams, piccoloist for the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra. The master class will be open to all registered festival attendees. Applicants will be judged based on accuracy of rhythm, intonation, and technique and overall interpretation and musicianship. Winners of the Piccolo Master Class Competition will prepare the recorded excerpts for the master class IN ADDITION to excerpts decided upon with the guest clinician prior to the festival.

Competition Requirements (recordings must be emailed and registration forms & payment must be postmarked by 5:00 pm on February 15th, 2018):

Record THREE orchestral excerpts or one piccolo solo of your choice. No accompaniment is required but is recommended for solo repertoire.

- The recording must be **unedited**, however, excerpts/different movements may be recorded on different tracks. *Edited recordings will be disqualified.*
- Do not speak or make any identifying sound on your recording.

To Submit Your Recording:

1) Email your recording in MP3 format to louisianaflutecompetition@gmail.com no later than 5:00 pm on February 15, 2018.

- In the subject line of your email, enter LFS 2018 PICCOLO MASTER CLASS COMPETITION.
- In your email, include your name as you prefer it to be listed in the program.
- List your repertoire selection(s) in the order they are recorded.

*To be eligible for the Piccolo Master Class Competition, you are required to be a current member of the Louisiana Flute Society. Registration payment for the festival will pay annual membership dues.

Materials submitted after February 15 and/or without payment will not be considered.

3) Please make checks payable to **Louisiana Flute Society**; only one check is necessary for registration and competition entries. We cannot accept credit card payment at this time.
