# CASCO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES, REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2019 @ 7:00PM

Approved 11/19/2019

Call to Order: Allan Overhiser called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Overhiser, Brenner, Winfrey, 5 interested citizens, Tom Jessup, County Commissioner, Deputy Kurt Katje and Will Hart with Rural GIG.

Absent: Macyauski, surgery (heart transplant)

### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**Doug Nickerson** discussed Lake Shore Dr on how the lake is nibbling away at bluff. Doug mentioned that last summer the Road Commission closed part of Lake Shore Dr. Doug asked his attorney as to what are the rights of the residents of Miami Park in regard to Lake Shore Dr?

His attorney came back with this "I have confirmed by reference to the Miami Park Plat that Lake Shore Dr lies within the plat as such every lot owner within the plat enjoys an irrevocable easement right over the road, separate and apart from the, status or non-status, as a public road. The easement right can be lost thru adverse possession if it is effectively blocked for a fifteen-year period. Accordingly, you and your neighbors will want to take action to ensure the encroaching neighbor does not dispossess you of that right."

Doug is concerned about the portion of the road that is closed, the two neighbors that abut this portion of the road have fences that are on the road property, which is a violation.

The options are to either have the fences removed or a simple license agreement that acknowledges that the fences are intruding on the roadway.

Allan asked Doug if he is asking the township to intervene to preserve your rights as a private property owner of Miami Park? Doug said "Yes."

This will be addressed when we have a road meeting.

**Will Hart**, with RURAL GIG, asked for permission to explore the feasibility of working with Casco Township to construct a tower on the Township Hall parcel. The benefits of this project include:

- 1. Serving the Township Hall with broadband internet, including unlimited data
- 2. Providing, if desired, a public wifi hotspot in the Township Hall
- 3. Providing residents on 71<sup>st</sup> street, 107<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Blue Star Highway with connection point for broadband service
- 4. Providing free wifi at the Casco Township Nature Preserve, if desired.

Our exploration will involve using a drone at the Township Hall site to measure heights and potential connectivity to our equipment mounted on other towers. The tower would require a small amount of electricity.

Our goal would be to develop a proposal with costs for construction of a tower. If the Board has guidance or directives about any proposed tower, we would appreciate knowing that at your earliest convenience.

Allan asked what area this tower would service?

Allan told Will he would work with the Township and why don't you come up with a proposal for the township board to look at.

### Reports:

#### County:

Tom Jessup did a report on what is going on in Allegan at the Court House.

The court house renovation, a three phase project, will start some-time next year.

The entrance to the court house will be moved from the west side, which is the entrance now, to the center of the L shape of the building, this will be safer because prisoners can be brought right in to the court rooms. The cost of the whole project will be somewhere between 1 & 2 million.

The Public Defender's office is now in the court house.

County Commissioners are going to a four year term instead of 2 yrs.

#### Police:

Deputy Kurt Katje gave a brief report, September had 59 calls, he handled 24 of those calls, he made 48 traffic stops and wrote 4 tickets.

Kurt said the car is ready to go for winter.

### Clerk:

Cheri presented the minutes for the regular meeting of September 16, 2019.

Allan is working on an Insurance claim, he received an estimate from John Brush in the amount of \$72,500.00 to remove and repair the damaged stairs.

Miami Park stairs have held up pretty good thru the storm. If we are going to put stairs back at the preserve we are going to consider some general fund money to help with that project. If we are able to get a grant we will need to match the amount of the grant. According to pictures that Allan had, it looked like we lost almost all of the stairs at the preserve.

David Campbell said the committee is moving forward with provisions of the By-Laws which were done about twelve years ago.
