INTERNET & TECHNOLOGY POLICY
(UP TO & INCLUDING GRADE 10)

The Salem Free Public Library offers internet access to children as part of its mission to provide all patrons with access to a wide range of information & ideas.

However, the internet allows user to connect to networks & resources outside of the Salem Free Public Library (SFPL), & the internet is an unregulated medium. Some information may be inappropriate for children. The SFPL has designated some computer for use by children under the age of 14 and has installed on these computers various CD-ROM learning games. SFPL can also recommend resources and websites that are age appropriate.

Ultimately, the *SFPL cannot control an individual's access to other internet resources. **Parents and Guardians are responsible for information selected and accessed by their children.*** We strongly advise parents and guardians to supervise their children accessing the internet. The SFPL is not responsible for monitoring and has no control over the information on the internet and cannot be responsible for its content.

For initial internet use, effective 8/01/08, the SFPL is requiring parents/guardians to accompany their children to the library in order to sign the Internet & Technology Policy/Agreement Form. Children must also have a library card in order to access the internet and must abide by the general rules and regulations for internet use.

Lastly, privileges may be revoked if this child has an(y) outstanding obligations with the SFPL.
