

- We would like to welcome new Chapter to Pa. Allegheny County in the Pittsburgh area they have received a charter in late October. Their doing well, at last meeting already up past 20 members. Always good to have new members working with the League.
- There is a new Storm Water Authority in York County This authority is going to charge every house in the county \$48.90 a year. Farms will also be 48.90 plus \$9.00 tillable Acres which can be eliminate \$9 per tillable acre fee with an approved Ag. E&S / Conservation plan. Commercial will be on yearly rate of \$0.01205 per square foot. This can be up to you as residents of the county to let your County Commissioner know how you feel about this.
