


- Network of the Human Services Cabinet Secretaries from 18 states


Food Stamp spending represents a high burden to average taxpayers

\$804 - TAXES TO PAY FOR FOOD STAMPS FROM EACH NET FILER


\$12,800 - - FEDERAL INCOME TAX PAID BY THE MIDDLE 20% OF AMERICANS


The National JTPA Study

- Job Training Partnership Act of 1982
- Assessed impact of JTPA programs in 16 sites across the nation during the late 1980s and early 1990s.
 - Over 20,000 participants
 - Program was voluntary
- <u>Key finding</u>: Low to zero impacts on earnings
