## Mi Buenos Aires Querido, a photographic exhibition by Martin Cohen

 $T^{\text{he photographic exhibition on}}_{\text{Buenos Aires celebrates the}}$ passion and colors of one of Latin America's most remarkable cities and its bicentennial (200 years of independence). Many of the photographs were taken in La Boca, one of the oldest and most authentic neighborhoods of the capital. In this popular artists' quarter of Buenos Aires, we encounter a unique blend of old architecture and intense, primary colors, characteristic of its famous main promenade, Caminito. Special attention should also be paid to the murals of Pasaje Lanin in the neighboring barrio of Barracas. The extensive mosaics were created in 2000 by local artist Marino Santa Maria and cover a row of houses over the full length of a city block. Martin Cohen has visited Buenos Aires on many occasions; photos for this exhibition were taken in 2008.
