

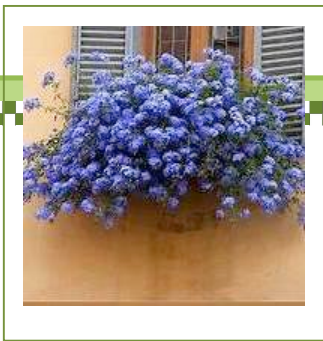

National, Native And Popular Flowers Of Italy

National Flower of Italy

The love for values, beliefs and customs of the Italians is easily seen in the symbolic flowers of Italy. The flower emblems of the country have been placed in to three categories-The traditional symbolic flower for Italy is **Rose** while, **White Poppy or White Lily** serves as the religious symbolic flower and according to popularity **Violet** is considered the flower of choice in the country.

Other Native and Popular Flowers of Italy

In Italy, the garden is reserved for vegetables and flowers are grown on the balcony, which makes for a healthy population and pretty houses. The flowers which the people love to grow in Italy are Oleanders, Bougainvillea, Jasmine, Crocus, Cyclamen, Bluebell, Violets, Periwinkles, Alpine Pasque Flower, Spring Gentians, Aquilegia, Aster Alpinus, Convolvulus, Cornflower, Cosmos Bipinnatus, Dahlia Semplicegazania, Geranium A Grandi Fiori, Giant Daisy Margherita Gigante, Lunaria O Moneta and Del Papa (Honesty Flower).

The most traditional flowers used for gifting in Italy are Orange -Tree Flower, White Lily, Violet, and White, Yellow And Pink Roses. To be avoided carefully is the Chrysanthemums, since in Italy it is said to be the flower of funerals and mourning.
