JKLM ENERGY PROJECT UPDATE, SEPTEMBER 28

Community Outreach Office Opens Today in Coudersport

WEXFORD, Pa. (Sept. 28) – JKLM Energy, LLC issued the following update to the public regarding the company's continuing response to the release of drilling chemicals at its Sweden Township, Potter County wellpad. These updates and related information are available at a project-specific website:

As of September 27, 2015, JKLM Energy, LLC has received a total of 29 lab results from water sources and surface water locations near the Reese Hollow 118 wellpad. Isopropanol, the chemical of principal concern in regard to the release from the drill site, has been detected in only one water well, with a total of four wells confirmed with levels of methylene blue activated substances (MBAS) above applicable standards. MBAS are used to test for the presence of surfactants. Isopropanol and MBAS were not detected in 24 samples to date.

As mentioned previously, preliminary results from the nearby Hershey Pond were also received and indicate the presence of MBAS, consistent with foamy water conditions observed in the pond. JKLM is continuing to reach out to residents between the well pad and the Hershey Pond. The company is treating this result as if it is from the release, but the presence of MBAS could also be traced to other sources, including household laundry detergent and soap. Samples are being taken daily at the pond following the discovery of the issue. A hydrogeologist has also been retained to map the aquifer in which the chemicals were released at the wellpad. Residents in this area who notice a change in their water quality or have other concerns can to contact Dean Boorum at (814) 598-3960 to schedule a water well inspection/sample and receive a supply of bottled water while the sample is being analyzed.

The JKLM Community Outreach office is now open at 200 N. West St. in Coudersport and will be staffed from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The public is invited to visit the office to talk with project managers, and view maps and related information about the company's response efforts.

JKLM is continuing to work closely with local officials as well as the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to limit the release's impact to the community and restore the local water aquifer to pre-drilling quality.
