

- Small claim review had to be filed by July 30. No filing was received.
- August 2, I attended the one-day class 'Ethics for the Assessor' held at the Ontario County Training Facility. This course is a state requirement for all assessors that will be reappointed this fall as our current appointment term ends 9/30/19. The new six-year appointment runs 10/1/19-9/30/25, for which this course applies.
- All sales/transfers, address changes and escrow updates were added to RPS and the file was ready for the county to begin the school tax bill process.
- Field review and processing of building permits continues.
- Star Enhanced forms have been updated for the 2020-2021 school year. Anyone currently receiving the Basic Star savings on their school tax bill, turning age 65 by December 31, **2020**, and the total 2018 combined income of all the owners, and of any owners' spouses residing on the premises is \$88,050 or less, can apply for the exemption. The website has been updated and I also placed a folder with applications on the bulletin board in the vestibule.

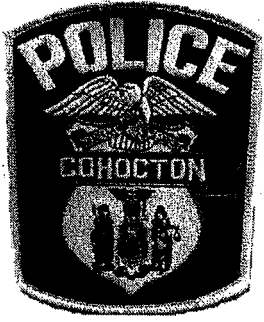

I hereby submit the July 2019 Monthly report of activities for the Town of Cohocton Police Department.

2. The Town, Community and most important the Family should be in everyone's thoughts and prayers for a local young lady lost her life due to injuries sustained due to a motor vehicle accident in the Township of Cohocton. I would like to express my thanks to the NYS Police, Cohocton Ambulance for the professional demeanor and the endless effort these Folks administered to try and save a life. This hit close to myself for I worked with the mother of this young lady in Law Enforcement Profession.

3. During the month of July there has been 3 different ATV/ UTV accidents that has caused bodily injury to the operators of these off road vehicles. The injuries have all been severe and caused the victims to be transported by either Ambulance or Life flight if one was available to a Hospital, once at these facilities the victims injuries on two occasions were severe enough to be rushed into surgery. Although these vehicles can bring a family a lot of joy and together time, parental guidance should be conducted and adhered to at all times while being operated by the youth.

4. Although numbers don't always show the business of our work, just to put into perspective of what is done. Officer Bardeen, Officer Bastine and Officer Hines handled 2 Harassment complaints, 2 trespass complaints, 2 locate a Person for another Agency, 1 Warrant, along with a larceny of a bicycle that had been stolen, investigated then located a suspect with property being retrieved and

returned to rightful owner. This type of complaint takes numerous hours to handle. I believe this larceny small in nature but just as important to the victim consumed approximately three and a half hours from start to finish. The PD also took numerous other complaints that these Officers had to handle Along with numerous traffic stops that resulted into tickets or warnings. I believe The Police Agency is doing a very good job and I would like to extend an offer to any Board Member or public person to stop by either officer or myself and express what their concerns might be. Together we will make the Township a nicer safer place to live.
