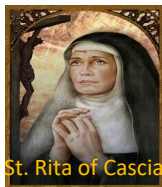

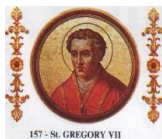

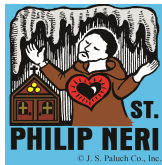

**†SAINTS/FEASTS OF THE WEEK†**

**May 21-St. Christopher Magallanes and Companions**-St. Christopher Magallanes and 21 other Mexican priests, along with 3 lay people, were martyred by the anti-Catholic government in Mexico for their support of the Cristero Revolt.

**May 22-St. Rita of Cascia**-An Augustinian nun, St. Rita was a widow whose husband suffered a violent death and also lost her two sons. While praying before a crucifix, she received a stigmata of a wound Jesus received from the crown of thorns. St. Rita is the patron saint of impossible causes.

**May 25-St. Bede the Venerable**- Considered one of the most learned men of his time, St. Bede was an English monk with a major influence on English literature. His best known work is *Historia Ecclesiastica*, an account of Christianity in England up to the year 729.

**-St. Gregory VII**-One of the greatest popes of medieval times, St. Gregory VII was pope from 1073 until his death in 1085 and is best known for his part in the Investiture Controversy.

**-St. Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi**-An Italian Carmelite nun and mystic, St. Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi was distinguished for her intense prayer life and devotion to receive Holy Communion frequently.

**May 26-St. Philip Neri**-A Christian missionary and founder of the Congregation of the Oratory, St. Philip Neri was an Italian priest who was known as the Third Apostle of Rome after Sts. Peter and Paul.

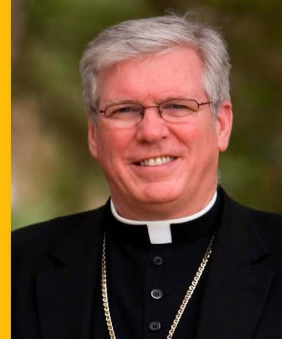

The Diocese of Venice continues to promote **Share the Journey**, a worldwide two-year initiative of Our Holy Father, Pope Francis. The Diocese will continue to run a series designed to answer questions focusing more specifically on Refugee Resettlement. This will serve as an aide to build bridges of reconciliation, understanding and hospitality, in keeping with the spirit of **Share the Journey**. The topics covered include: "What Does the Gospel Say About Refugees?", "What is the Economic Impact?" and "Are Refugees a Burden?", etc.

Below are the first two topics of the series. It is the request of Bishop Frank J. Dewane that ALL PARISHES publish the text in their Sunday bulletins:

## What Does the Gospel Say About Refugees?

1. The Catholic Church in the United States has been helping immigrants and refugees since the founding of this nation. Indeed, it is what the Gospel calls us to do: in Matthew (25:35) Jesus tells his disciples, "I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me." *Source: Matthew, Chapter 25*

2. Refugees are fleeing persecution and violence and have suffered great loss, including loss of their homes, livelihoods, possessions and families. Only 1% of these refugees get resettled. Migration Refugee Services (MRS) assists with food, clothing, shelter, employment, English as a second language, and orientation to a new community and culture. *Source: MRS*

3. MRS works to create "a world where immigrants, refugees, migrants, and people on the move are treated with dignity, respect, welcome and belonging." *Source: MRS Vision Statement.*

## How Do Refugees Contribute?

1. Refugees must pay back the cost of their travel to America through a loan arrangement with the International Organization for Migration, a U.S. Department of State contractor. Flight costs range from \$1,500-\$9,000. The U.S. is the only resettlement country that requires refugees to pay for their transportation. *Source: MRS*

2. The MRS resettlement agency network of over 80 affiliates hire employment specialists to prepare refugees for the job market. Eighty five percent of refugees get a job and are self-sufficient within six months of arrival. *Source: MRS Refugee Research Blog*

3. Refugees find work far earlier in the U.S. than in other countries and start businesses at a quicker pace than the U.S.-born population. *Sources: Chmura Economics & Analytics; MPI*

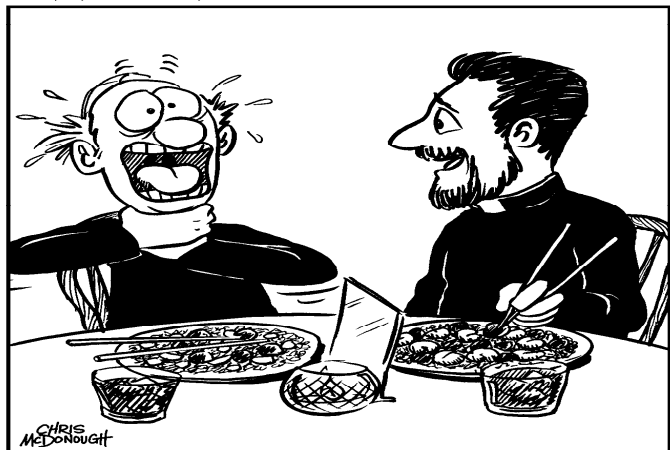

### ALL ARE SENT

Fifty days after Easter Sunday we celebrate the fulfillment of all God's promises in the feast of Pentecost, a feast that has sometimes been called the birthday of the church. One last time we are reminded that we Christians have received the Holy Spirit, not for our own benefit, but to enable us to follow our Christian vocation.

The centerpiece of the scriptures for Pentecost is the account in Acts of the Apostles of the sending of the Holy Spirit to the disciples. The other readings for this Sunday help us to understand what it means to live out our Christian vocation. Paul's letter shows us the gifts and fruits that the Holy Spirit gives to us. John's Gospel reminds us that Jesus has sent all his disciples to share his forgiveness and peace, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The disciples gathered on the fiftieth day after the Resurrection were not keeping their first Pentecost. For them, Pentecost was the fiftieth day after Passover, a feast of the first fruits of the harvest. It was the second most important feast of the year. Today, Jews gather on the eve of the feast to study scripture and the law, and after the feast begins at sundown, spend the day in joyful social gatherings. The meaning of the celebration is the giving of the law on Mount Sinai, so for Christians the connection to the gifts of the Holy Spirit is obvious. In Sicily and in the Pantheon in Rome, today the descent of the Holy Spirit is enacted with a stunning ritual. Some churches there have an "eye" in the roof open to the sky, called an *oculus*. After the Gospel today, thousands of rose petals fall from the *oculus* onto the assembly. Churches and homes are decked in greenery and flowers to express the new life the Holy Spirit brings on this, the "birthday of the church."

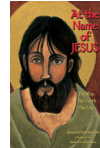
