The Lauderserv app allows users to submit customer service requests right from their mobile device.

Neighbors can report a streetlight outage, clogged stormdrain, pothole, or broken waste cart; find out collection days for sanitation, recycling and bulk trash; discover how to pay a water bill or parking ticket online; and much, much more. Lauderserv can also be used to access the City's social media accounts and get beach conditions.
