SMMUSD Extension Allocation \$44,426:

All funds have been encumbered and all funds will be expended by the end of the grant period (December 31st)

SMC's Co-Project Director has been recruiting CTE department representatives from the college to join the consortium effort with the intent of developing noncredit courses and certificate program for Adult Education students.
