"Be Strong and Courageous"

"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go." Joshua 1:7 During the 100 year's war between France and England, the English lost a battle they were expected to win. When someone asked the general what happened, he said, "Never underestimate the ability of an overconfident army to snatch defeat right out of the jaws of victory." Life is a battle.
