April 23-St. George—A Roman soldier of Greek and Palestinian origin, St. George, a Christian martyr, was sentenced to death for refusing to recant his Christian faith.

St. Adalbert—A Bohemian missionary, St. Adalbert was martyred due to his efforts to convert the Baltic Prussians to Christianity.

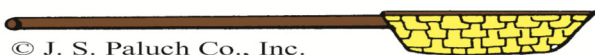
April 24-St. Fidelis of Sigmaringen—A Franciscan Capuchin monk and former lawyer, St. Fidelis was a major figure in the Counter-Reformation, and was murdered by his opponents.

April 25-St. Mark—Author of the second Gospel, St. Mark is said to have founded the Church of Alexandria.

April 28-St. Peter Chanel—A Catholic priest, missionary and martyr, St. Peter Chanel was murdered by order of King Niuliki of Fortuna for attempting to baptize his son.

St. Louis Grignion de Manfort—A French Roman Catholic priest and Confessor, St. Louis Grignion de Manfort was a Marian devotee, and founder of the Sisters of Divine Wisdom.

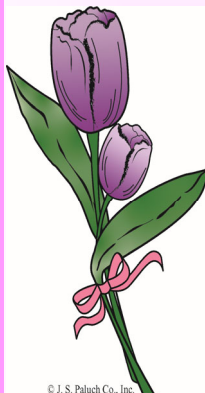

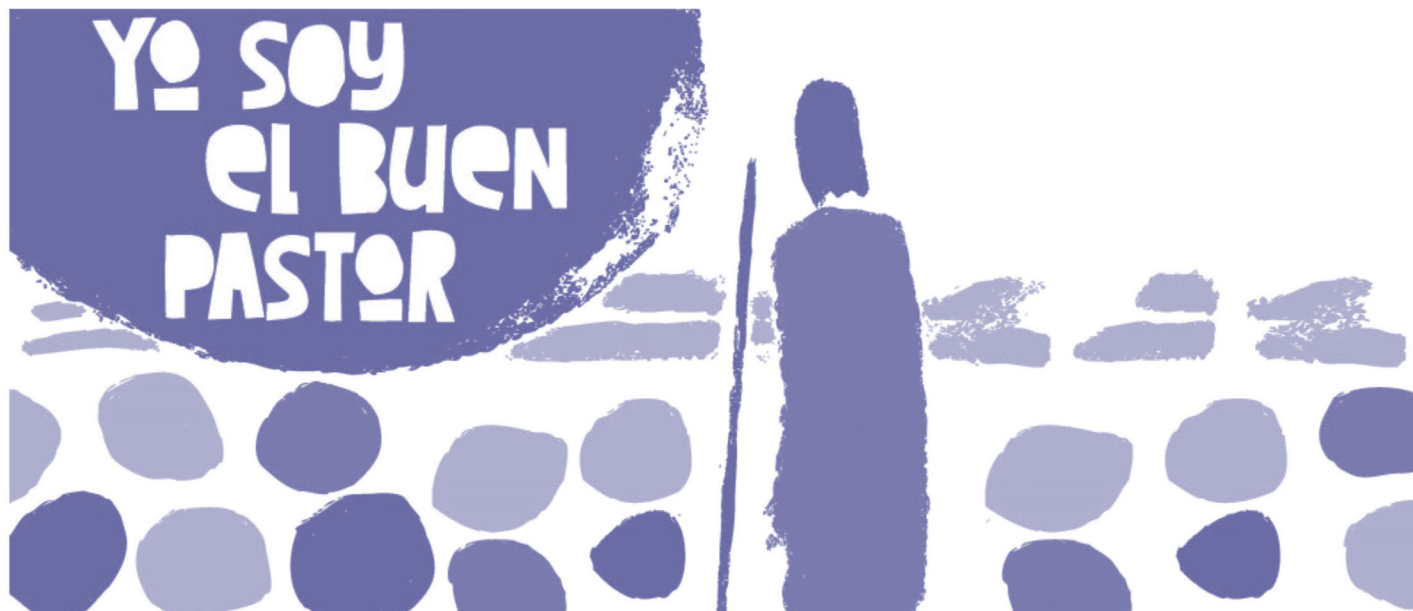

En el Antiguo Testamento, muchas veces Dios es descrito como el pastor del pueblo de Israel. Así cuando Jesús invoca esta imagen de Dios para describirse así mismo, sorprende aún a sus propios discípulos. En el Evangelio de hoy, él toma esta imagen un paso adelante del Antiguo Testamento, como el Buen Pastor, él pastor “debe dar su vida”. Esta frase se afirma, con algunas variaciones, cinco veces en el corto pasaje de hoy. Jesús está describiendo el significado de su vida y de su muerte.

Con firmes raíces en la historia de Israel y su Dios, Jesús está ahora empezando un nuevo capítulo. Él está ayudando a sus discípulos a darle sentido a su muerte, él está revelando el infinito amor que él y el Padre tienen por su rebaño. Para seguir a Jesús, ser una parte del rebaño de Jesús, significa participar en el mismo sacrificio de amor.

UN REBAÑO

Jesús añade otra característica a la imagen del pastor, la cual también inquieto a sus discípulos. Él se refiere a “otras

ovejas que no son de mi rebaño” pero serán una parte del mismo rebaño. Esto probablemente se refiere a los gentiles, a otros pueblos más allá de Israel. El Pastor aumenta su rebaño, pero enfatiza que solo hay un solo rebaño. Jesús habló con fuerza y frecuentemente, especialmente en el Evangelio de Juan, de la importancia de la unidad de aquellas personas que lo siguen.

Nosotros, quienes seguimos a Jesús, debemos de recibir a “las otras ovejas” para respetar y celebrar las diferencias entre los cristianos. Debemos de aprender del otro, de la otra persona. Todas estas cosas que parecen dividir a los seguidores de Jesús en la cultura, la etnicidad o los conflictos de la historia se desvanecen en comparación con la unidad más profunda de un solo rebaño con un solo pastor. Vivir unidos es esencial para que seamos testigos fieles y creíbles de Cristo en el mundo.

SAVED BY THE ONE WHO WAS REJECTED

Some city teenagers often scorn and reject farm kids. Yet it's no exaggeration to say that humanity owes its life to farmers who care for the world's crops and livestock. This week's scriptures remind us that Jesus was as rejected as a shepherd, a farm boy, yet we owe our very lives to him.

In this Sunday's reading from the Acts of the Apostles Peter tells the people that salvation comes through Jesus Christ, the one who was rejected. In John's letter we hear that we have become God's beloved children through Jesus, whom the world did not know. Lastly, in the Gospel Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd who "lays down his life for the sheep" (John 10:11). Will you join Jesus in laying down your life for God's beloved flock?

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TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Most languages take the name for this fifty-day season from the Lord's Passover: *Pasqua* in Italian, *Pâques* in French, *Paach* in Dutch, *Pascha* in Greek and Russian. English has a much newer name, the name of a pagan goddess, *Easter*. For centuries before Christianity took hold, in both Germany and Britain the spring equinox was dedicated to her and the concepts of fertility and rebirth. She was said to be a playful spirit, following the Sun King's chariot, and ending the reign of winter. She had a magical companion, a rabbit who hid eggs in the fields to coax plants and animals to rebirth. It was believed that *Easter* once came across a bird with broken wings and saved it by turning it into a rabbit—an egg-laying rabbit at that! Although they were baptized, most people didn't take to the new Latin name (*Pascha Domini*) too easily, and kept calling the spring equinox by the old accustomed name. For good measure, they kept a pagan name for Christmas, too: *Yule*. —Rev. James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

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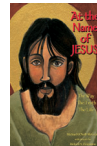
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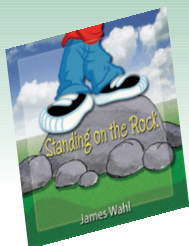
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
