

Symphonic Chorale Auditions

The Symphonic Chorale is the premiere, auditioned, concert choir at Nordonia High School. While there is not a pre-determined number of members, Mr. Pickering determines membership based upon audition results.

How Do I Audition?

- 1.) Sign up for a 5 minute audition slot on the choir board.
 - a. Auditions for current high school students will be:
 - i. Monday – Wednesday, April 16 – 18
 - ii. In High School Choir Room
 - b. Auditions for current 8th Graders will be:
 - i. Thursday & Friday, April 19 – 20.
 - ii. In Middle School Choir Room

- 2.) Sight-Reading
 - a. You will be asked to sing something you have never seen before.
 - i. Don't stress out about this. Many people auditioning have little to no experience.

- 3.) Prepared Music
 - a. Sing your voice part (SATB) of the attached piece of music.
 - i. If you are unsure of your voice part, see Mr. Pickering for help.

 - b. Prepare highlighted section of music.
 - i. Red – Soprano
 - ii. Purple – Alto
 - iii. Yellow – Tenor
 - iv. Green – Bass

 - c. Part dominant learning tracks can be found on the choir website at:

 - i. Learning tracks play your vocal line in one ear and the other 3 in the opposite ear.

 - a. High School Help Session

 - i. Tuesday, April 10; 3:00 – 3:45 in MS Choir Room.
