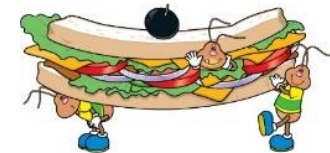
July 13 Bonfire/picnic at the Parsonage from

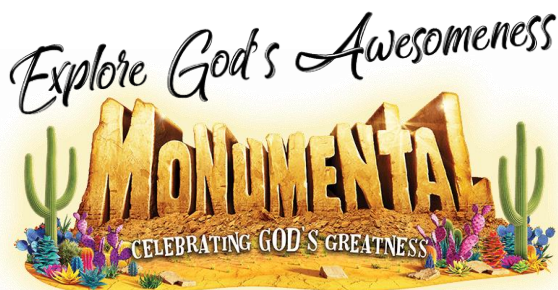
There is a sign up sheet in the narthex. The ride will take place on

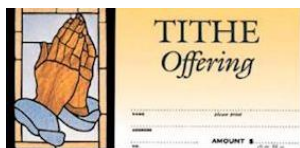
Go to the Play Store on any Android phone or The App Store on any I Phone. Once there, **type in:** "South Harborcreek UMC APP" and install.

You'll find registration forms in the narthex which need to be completed and handed in no later than July 10.



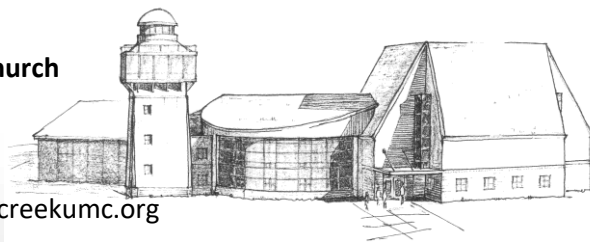
