## **Green Dot Tournament**

On Saturday August 16, 2014 PTC will be hosting for the first time the Boys and Girls 12 and under Green Dot Classic. For those who are not familiar with Green Dot tennis balls, they are designed to reduce speed by 25% compared to regular tennis balls which offers better control for longer rallies. This will be a one day tournament which is designed to provide all participants with an opportunity to play a minimum of three matches. Format for the tournament will be established once it is determined how many participants are in the tournament. The participants usually play best 2 out of 3 short sets – first to 4 games (win by 2) no ad scoring, 7 point tiebreaker at 4 – 4: 7 point tie breaker for the 3rd set.

We need volunteers to help make this event a success.
