- Flea Market at Dechairo Park grounds

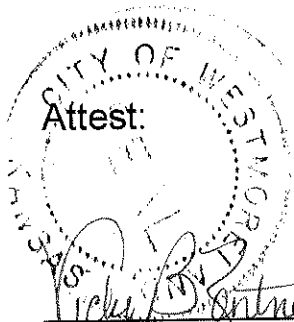
- Lighting, planters, benches, etc., on Main Street
