4. Old Business

4. Old Business continued

Mykola Myronowskyj is still currently working on the 2020 Forest Grove equipment audit.

The MUA's for the surrounding locals will need to be updated. Mykola Myronowskyj is currently working on them and will submit them to the Board for review and approval once they have been finalized.

The bookkeeper is currently working to rectify the discrepancy that was found on the balance sheet regarding the total fixed assets. Apparently, a simple journal entry was made in the accounting software. This was the incorrect type of entry and we are working to have the figure corrected to reflect the proper total fixed assets as represented on the audits.

The 2003 Ford Excursion is at its end of life. Mykola Myronowskyj had the Chief obtain estimates to fully repair the vehicle to be operational before any repairs are made. The estimates were received, and they are in excess of \$4,000.00 to make the needed repairs to make the vehicle road worthy and safe. Andrew Bellone Jr made a motion and Samuel Scapellato seconded the motion to take the vehicle out of service The Board unanimously agreed that the vehicle is to be taken off of the road and if possible, sold. Mykola Myronowskyj will look into selling the vehicle with Brindlee Mountain. If we cannot sell the vehicle, we will then use it as a training aid and practice vehicle extrication with it.

5. New Business

2021 Budget voting and approval was completed. The Board is now on the new NJ FAST system. The vote was taken, and the forms returned to the State of NJ electronically.

The petition for nomination for the open Board seat for the 2021 election was received from Andrew Bellone Jr. This is the only petition for nomination that was received to date.

A discussion was had regarding the potential purchase of a new station vehicle. This discussion was necessary so that the question to purchase the vehicle could be put on the ballot in the 2021 election. If approved by the voters, the vehicle could be purchased in the 2022 calendar year. This vehicle is to be purchased as a station vehicle and not to replace the current Deputy Chiefs vehicle.

The Chief submitted estimates for a vehicle to be purchased through state contract. After a lengthy debate, the Board unanimously agreed that a question should be put on the ballot for the purchase of a new station vehicle in 2022, and not to exceed \$50,000.00 to be paid from reserve capitol funds.
