

#### WE ARE INVITED!

Bishop Thomas extends the following invitation to all of us:

"On Sunday, September 10, 2017 at 3:00 PM, Bishop Daniel Beaudoin of the Northwestern Ohio Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) and I will lead a joint Commemoration of the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation at St. Michael the Archangel Church in Findlay (750 Bright Road).

Our prayer service will follow the model of what took place last October when Pope Francis united in prayer with the Lutherans at Lund, Sweden. In his homily at Lund, Pope Francis insisted that Catholics and Lutherans must 'look with love and honesty at our past, recognizing error and seeking forgiveness.'

The joint Diocesant/Synod Service on September 10th, entitled 'Together in Hope,' will highlight the five ecumenical imperatives. It will also serve as a means of preparation and inspiration for our local communities to organize their own commemorations as the date of the 500th anniversary, October 31, draws closer.

With more that 250 Catholic and Lutheran congregations represented, this would highlight recognition of the commemoration to extend throughout all of Northwest Ohio. Additionally, plans are underway for a joint Lutheran-Catholic choir to help lead the September 10th service. Your parish singers are most welcome to also take part. A reception for all will follow afterwards along with suggestions for ways to witness our ecumenical mission of mercy in the world today."

Opportunities such as these, help to deepen our awareness and appreciation of other Christians in our area who seek to live the Gospel message. While of benefit to all, this time can be especially helpful to those families that embrace both the Catholic and Lutheran traditions.

While there will be a section of general seating open on a first come first served basis, we do have a limited number of reserved seating tickets for anyone who is interested. These can be obtained by calling the parish office.

# **Religious Education Connection**

#### St. Augustine August 28

St. Augustine became bishop of Hippo. He was an early Christian theologian and philosopher, and is considered a Doctor of the Church. His writing influenced the development of Western philosophy along with Western Christianity. Here are a few of his famous quotes.

"Faith is to believe what you do not see; the reward of this faith is to see what you believe."

"Pray as though everything depended on God. Work as though everything depended on you."

"You aspire to great things? Begin with little ones."

"Resentment is like drinking poison and waiting for the other person to die."

If you believe what you like in the gospels, and reject what you don't like, it is not the gospel you believe, but yourself."

"Seek not to understand that you may believe, but believe that you may understand."

"Charity is no substitute for justice withheld."

"Patience is the companion of wisdom."

"He that is kind is free, though he is a slave; he that is evil is a slave, though he be a king."

Beer has been around for--well, almost--forever. For centuries, it was used as a form of currency. Wages were paid in beer, even for child laborers. Due to St. Augustine's conversion from a dissolute life, which included wild drinking parties, he is the patron saint of brewers.

Alcohol does not fully bake out of dishes unless they are cooked for hours, but baking does reduce the alcohol significantly. For this recipe, the type of beer you choose will alter the flavor of the dish; but if it is your favorite beer, it will be a great combination.

Tuna fishing was a major industry in the area of the ancient city of Hippo and is still today. The tuna is so valuable, that modern-day tuna poachers have seriously diminished the number.

#### **Tuna Cheese Pie**

Drain and flake a total of 14 oz tuna

Arrange in a baked 10" pie shell: the tuna and

1 C shredded cheese

Sprinkle over the mixture: 1 T flour

Beat together: 3 eggs, 1/2 t salt, 1/2 t dry mustard

dash of cayenne pepper

Beat In: 1/2 C beer, 1 C heavy cream

Pour over tuna-cheese mixture.
