John C. Moore, age 85, of Millington, formerly of Elkton, passed away, Tuesday afternoon, August 14, at the Tuscola County Medical Care Facility, Caro. He was born May 25, 1922, in Greenleaf Twp, near Cass City to the late Claude and Edna (Wurtz) Moore. John served in the US Army during WW II.
