# certificate in jungian psychotherapy

The School's **Certificate in Jungian Psychotherapy** program provides education in applying the Jungian ideas in the clinical practice of psychotherapy as legally defined in the Colorado Mental Health Statute: especially CRS 12-43-201(9) and CRS 12-43-202. The **Certificate in Jungian Therapy** program requires successful completion of five (5) classes. The cost of the **Certificate** program is **\$3,000.00** (5 classes x \$600.00). Courses are available in classroom, intensive, and independent study formats. Classes may also be taken separately as "stand alone" courses at the cost of \$600.00 each.

## Class Offerings

Students must complete the following five classes offered to successfully complete their Certificate.

1. Jungian Theory
2. Jungian Therapy
3. Jungian Theory and Play Therapy
4. Archetypes
5. Jungian Case Conference / Practicum

Classes are also available in a distance learning / independent study format.

## Prerequisites

A minimum of an undergraduate degree or two years of practical experience is required to enter the School's **Certificate in Jungian Psychotherapy** program.
