A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR FRED

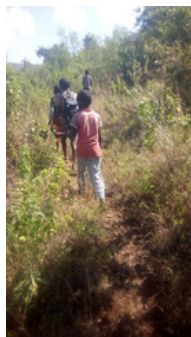
