DISCUSSION	<p>Jonlee Anderle provided an update on the issues surrounding the Chemical Testing Lab. Lack of law enforcement support was the issue presented. The lab advised that a lack of personnel and equipment was the issue. The subcommittee was presented testimony from several sources and the overall recommendation was to ask the Department of Health for updated equipment and personnel.</p> <p>Dr. Greg Dooley presented information on a partnership with the Analytical Toxicology Laboratory of CSU. See PowerPoint.</p> <p>Scott Jones of Casper Police Department provided testimony concerning the results of samples sent to the lab and the screening results. Solid chemical results are imperative to data collection, enforcement and prosecution.</p> <p>Attorney General Michael advised that based on the State Budget prioritizing requests is an issue. A recommendation needs to be made to the Department of Health in a timely manner. User fee for offenders was discussed and a plausible alternative.</p>

DISCUSSION	<p>The Council met in July and will again meet in August. The committee is made up of State of Wyoming Division Directors providing a large cross section of state government who could see an impact from the legalization of medical and recreational marijuana. A report is being produced which will provide article reviews, review of scientific literature, revenue issues, local control issues, education system impacts, etc. It will provide educational information to the citizens of Wyoming.</p>
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DISCUSSION	<p>WASCOP has developed a Marijuana Education grass roots program and to coordinate the process hired Rhea Parsons. Information and support for the campaign is being garnered statewide with letters of support and monetary donations to continue the media and education program. A position paper was developed and is in the final editing stages. Grant funding for the campaign is being requested from the Daniels Fund and other foundations with an estimated two year budget of \$1,000,000.00.</p>
