Convention Rules and Expectations

** Please read and observe the following rules and expectations. Students who do not observe the rules are subject to disciplinary action, which may include but is not limited to, being sent home at the expense of the parents and the loss of membership in the Kentucky Junior Classical League.

1. The possession and/or consumption of alcohol and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. *Suspicion* of the possession or use of such is grounds for a search of luggage, rooms, and/or clothing.
2. No tobacco products are permitted.
3. No improper fraternization. This includes indecent public displays of affection, being on the floors or in the rooms of the opposite gender, and offensive gestures while dancing.
4. Show respect for your peers, teachers, chaperones, and special guests at all times.
5. Every student must attend all assemblies, seminars, and fellowships. Students must stay in the convention area of the hotel during these activities. Students are not allowed in their rooms while scheduled activities are ongoing.
6. Every student must attend the testing session and complete at least 3 academic tests.
7. Convention attendees must wear nametags at all times. Nametags must be easily visible and located above the waist.
8. Dress Code: All attendees are expected to dress in an appropriate manner. The following are prohibited:
 - a. see-through clothing
 - b. revealing clothing that does not cover the back, midriff, and/or cleavage or chest
 - c. bare torsos or bare feet in any public area except the pool
 - d. clothing and/or accessories with offensive or obscene, crude or rude writing or pictures pertaining to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence, gangs, sex or racial context
 - e. skirts or shorts that are more than approximately 2" above the knee
 - f. leggings unless covered by a shirt/skirt that is not more than approx. 2" above the knee
 - g. tank tops that have straps less than 2" wide, i.e. spaghetti straps, ripped/cut tshirts.
 - h. exposed undergarments**This dress code applies to the entirety of convention – seminars, general assemblies/spirit, Ludi, dance, meals, Roman banquet, etc.
9. Every student must wear Roman attire to the Roman banquet. Roman attire must adhere to the KJCL dress code.
10. All students must be in their assigned rooms by curfew. Students are not allowed in the hallways after curfew.
11. Swimming is allowed during designated times only. Be safe: obey all pool rules – no horseplay!
12. Be courteous to all hotel guests. We are not the only patrons at the hotel. Do not congregate, run, or be loud in the hallways, stairwells, or elevators.
