Dear LTC Members:

Last year the summer league again lost money so we are going to continue with the 10 week season we started last year. The Board is going to try and recruit new shooters/teams to make up the difference this year. If you know of anybody who may be interested in shooting, please encourage them to join. All current members who bring a new shooter to the club will be given two free practice rounds per person. The board would also like to work on bringing back the games to league night. We are planning on having different games (16 yard Wobble, 5-stand, Oakley etc.) starting at 6pm on house number 7 every Wednesday night.

All members who bring a new shooter (or an old member who did not shoot last year) will receive two free practice rounds if that person signs up for leagues!

Dates:

The annual membership and pre-league meeting will be held at the Club House on *May 2nd* beginning at 6:00 pm. At this meeting, we will discuss the league schedule and answer any questions there may be concerning your club, etc. We will also be introducing a slate of new prospective board members and voting on them as a club.

Summer League will start Wednesday - May 30, 2018 and run through August 8, 2018. This is a ten week period. As July 4th falls on a Wednesday, we will not have leagues that week. Weather cancelations will be made up at the end of the season. Party night and the last night of the league will tentatively be scheduled for August 8th.

The Club will be open for practice starting $May 9^{th}$ on Wednesdays from 5-8pm (or darkness, whichever occurs first) and Sunday from 10am-2pm. After leagues start, we will open up on Tuesday evening from 5-8pm (or darkness, whichever occurs first). A work day is scheduled for $May 5^{th}$, starting at 9am. All members should make it a priority to attend so we can get ready for the season. We will also have work days on $June 9^{th}$ and $August 11^{th}$.

See attached team roster sheet, please complete and return to club on or by this meeting. They can also be mailed to the above address. Please bring the enclosed payment coupon to the meeting as well. We stress that the payment coupon form needs to be completed in its entirety so that we have a current address and phone number for all our members. We are also asking for your email

address. This way the board can communicate changes and events in a more effective and cost efficient way. The Laramie Trap Club will be using emails rather than mailings as much as possible in the future to help decrease the price of doing business. The Laramie Trap Club will be very careful with your email, it will not be shared or distributed. Fees: The league and membership fees may be paid in two (2) equal payments of \$105 each. First payment to be paid to the Club prior to starting date of May 23th; second payment to be paid to the Club

prior to or on July 11th. The assessed fees are as follows:

League fees: \$160.00 Membership fee: \$50.00 Total: \$210.00 When making payments; partial or in full, please use attached payment coupon completely filled out

Practice Round Policy: Practice round tickets will remain the same price; \$6/round for members and \$7/round for non-members. Practice round tokens must be purchased and paid for **prior** to shooting any practice round. The trap help will be instructed to not allow any shooter on the practice traps without first receiving a practice round pins from that shooter. These pins may be purchased at the office counter at any time during business hours and in any quantity desired. Ten (10) round punch cards are available at a discount price of \$55.00 for members of the LTC.

Pre-shooting of League Scores and Substitute Shooter(s): Post shooting will not be allowed. Pre-shooting is allowed anytime the club is open. Reminder of the 2014 RULE CHANGE-Only targets shot by the member will count on the score sheet. Substitute shooters are welcome to come and shoot the targets you have paid for but their score will not count for the team score. Please inform the trap kid if you have substitute shooter(s) so they know to draw a line through the score. Those not shooting their targets on a given night can receive a practice ticket for their targets instead of having someone shoot. Those not shooting their targets (either league night or pre shooting) will be given a score of their average minus two for singles and average minus two for handicap. Shooters must shoot all 10 weeks of the league to be eligible for high score awards given at the end of the league. An award will be given to the high shooter in singles, both men and women. A high shooter award will be given in each of the final team divisions for the best handicap score in that division. Divisions will be locked after 4 weeks of scores.

Trap House etiquette:

- 1) Shooting order.
- 2) There will be no "Reserving" a Trap House.
- 3) Rotate Trap House each week
