Message from Republic

Republic Services has been contracted by the Village of Tonica to provide village-wide residential waste collection and a variety of specialized services. As part of the program, all residents will soon receive 96-gallon waste and recycling carts. Recycling will continue to be collected every other Tuesday.

Residents will be allowed to set (1) bulk item out every other week on the same day trash is picked up, this will replace the annual spring cleanup. Bulk items will not be picked up on recycling weeks.

Weekly trash collection will continue to be picked up every Tuesday, with the exception of holidays - when collection will shift to the next day.

We understand there will be some growing pains with the new service roll-out, but we're confident this guide will help us provide a timely service. Please contact us at customerservice792@republicservices.com or 815-434-2035 with any questions regarding the program.

Senior citizen waste program

Republic Services will be making smaller carts available for senior citizens. While senior citizens can request a smaller cart by contacting the Village of Tonica directly, we ask that residents wait 60 days after the initial distribution before any changes in cart sizes can be made. Please consider that large carts are meant to not only accommodate the regular weekly amount of trash but also the very heavy times like holidays, family gatherings, and birthday parties.

Additional carts

Additional carts may be rented for \$3.25 each per month and are billed directly to the resident.

Roll-off boxes

Roll off boxes ranging from 10 to 30 cubic yards are available for large cleanout or construction projects. Please contact Republic Services for pricing and availability.
