December Business:

We covered a lot of important business this month so we are making it the headline of the minutes.

- PARK LIST: There is a park list on the table in the Rec Hall please check if your information is correct if so mark it "OK" otherwise make the changes so we may update the list. Do not take it from the table.
- GARBAGE ISSUES: During the holidays there is more garbage than usual, break down boxes, flatten plastic and save space. Garbage is picked up Monday, Wednesday and Friday. We will lose a garbage day each week since the holidays are on Wednesday. If you wish to recycle Hube and Lisa will take clean and flattened plastic and cardboard. ALSO: Do not leave ANY items on the ground next to or around the dumpster. The driver will not pick it up, he will not load your trash. If you have an issue with large items that will not fit in dumpster Keep it at your place and see Laura for help. Don't dump your junk on everyone else!
- DOG ISSUES: No dog should be walking on anyone's lawn. Use the common areas of the park. If you don't know where they are ASK LAURA! Once again we are addressing poop! Really? If your dog poops...PICK IT UP! If you see someone walking their dog and not picking it up offer them a bag. We don't want anyone to confront anyone else but make a note of time, day and location and report it to Laura. Most everyone is thoughtful but there are a few (or one) that are causing a problem. Also do not let your dog pee on anyone's lawn. You may not see it but other dogs do and will continue to pee there killing plants and lawns. So many work hard to keep their place nice, making this a beautiful park DON'T make it harder for them.
- LAUNDRY ISSUES: DO NOT wash any dog bedding in the machines. It is nearly impossible to clean up your mess. Many have issues with dog allergies, others just do not want to wear your dog's hair. If your dog sheds on your clothes, shake the hair from your clothes before you wash them, if you can't remove the hair from your clothes use a commercial washer at a public laundry NOT HERE! This is for your neighbors. Be considerate.
- DRIVING ISSUES: We had speed bumps through out the park and removed them with the understanding residents will not speed and endanger others in the park. It has become an issue once again with residents, guests of residents (which you are responsible for) and delivery trucks. Laura has addressed the delivery drivers and their companies. We are now addressing the residents. The speed limit is 10 mph! Yes TEN MILES PER HOUR! It may feel like you're crawling but you are protecting your neighbors and pets around the park. With shorter days there is more of an issue with walking after dark. All the more reason to SLOW DOWN and please use your lights on your golf carts. If you don't have lights on your golf cart use a flashlight. Use a flashlight when you walk. Put a reflector or light tag on your dog. If your dog is on a retractable leash 5 feet from you and your flashlight drivers can't see them only you.
- PROPERTY ISSUES: Do not walk on or through anyone's property other than your own. No one should be cutting through lots even if they are not home! It is their place and you are trespassing.
- COPY OF PARK RULES: If you would like a copy of the park rules see Laura. She will have copies available.
- RENT INCREASE: There will be a rent increase starting January 1st, 2020 for Full Time Year Round \$375, starting November 1st, 20202 for Seasonal Occupied (unit stays on lot) \$3500. It is the first increase in 3 years and it is at the lowest possible amount while still covering ever rising costs.
