



January 11, 2021 - COVID Update

Greetings from Midway Nursing Home!

There are no new cases of COVID-19 for residents or staff. One positive resident remains asymptomatic. No other staff or residents have any COVID-19 symptoms. At present, one floor remains on precautionary isolation per DOH guidance until January 21st. Close monitoring of all residents and limited movement of both staff and residents remains in place. Weekly testing of residents and twice weekly testing of staff continues.

Visitation remains on “pause” but virtual visits are encouraged and available every day through the Social Work and Recreation Departments. Please contact them to schedule this.

As a precautionary measure, all packages sent or dropped off for residents are sanitized and held for 24 hours before giving to our residents so please plan accordingly.

CVS Health has confirmed that they will return to our facility on January 20th to administer the 2nd doses and 1st doses for newly admitted residents and residents who have not yet received the vaccine. If you still need to give your consent for your loved one to receive the COVID vaccine, please call the facility as soon as possible to give your consent to a registered nurse. As the COVID positivity rates continue to rise across our area, we ask that you and your families take extra precautions to be safe.
