

Pastors of Oakland Scholarship Program 2015 - 2016

The objective of this scholarship program is to assist in bringing the Shalom of the City of Oakland by investing in College – Bound and College students, and students at the Middle School and High school levels as they pursue their education.

The focus will be on youth involved in and encouraged to be involved in volunteer work in the Church & Community through evangelism, outreach, and community services.

A minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 will be mandatory for qualifying applicants.

A 500 word essay detailing why the applicant deserves the Scholarship will be a determing factor in the selection process.

- 1. The three areas from which applicants will be selected are; North, East, and West Oakland.
- 2. The application will be made available through the Pastors of Oakland in the targeted areas.
- 3. Three one thousand dollar scholarship will be given to three selected students.
- 4. Applicants must show proof of enrollment and attendance at their school.
- 5. Applicants must submit a copy of their latest progress report.
- 6. All applicants will be required to attend an interview session with the scholarship committee.
- 7. Two letters of recommendation will be required from students, their Pastor and a school official.
- The deadline for submitting the application will be January 5, 2016.
  Scholarship awards will be made March 31, 2016.
