

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Town of Walkertown
2023 Street Repair Contract
Walkertown, North Carolina

Sealed bids for Street Repairs and Resurfacing will be received by the Town of Walkertown Town Hall, 5177 Main St, Walkertown, North Carolina 27051 until **3:00 P.M. Friday, March 17, 2023** and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The work will include the following items:

Work consists of milling existing asphalt pavement (6,900 sy), full depth patching of existing pavement (52 tons), and asphalt concrete surface course (830 tons).

Plans and specifications are on file for inspection at Walkertown Town Hall and at the office of the Engineers in Burlington, North Carolina. Blank forms of Proposal, with Specifications and Plans, shall be obtained from Alley, Williams, Carmen & King, Inc. upon request.

Consideration will be given only to bids of Contractors who submit evidence that they are licensed under "An Act to Regulate the Practice of General Contracting", ratified by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina on March 10, 1925, and as subsequently amended, when such Act is applicable.

A pre-bid conference is scheduled for **2:00 P.M., Tuesday, March 7, 2023** via Zoom. Engineer to issue invitation to all Bidders that download plans.

Each Proposal shall be accompanied with a deposit of cash or CERTIFIED CHECK on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in an amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the Proposal, said check to be made payable to the Town of Walkertown.

In lieu of the above cash or CERTIFIED CHECK, the bidder may execute a Bid Bond for the same amount.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 30 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities. By order of the Town Council of Walkertown, North Carolina.
