agreement between the Sheriff's Office, municipal Police Departments, and senior adults in the community to work together in an effort to prevent seniors from becoming victims of crime.

TRIAD is... a COUNTY

joint approach to crime issues that affect older citizens. It is, essentially, a specialized delivery of law enforcement services and current crime information to our community's seniors.

TRIAD is

accomplished by working to form S.A.L.T. (Seniors And Law Enforcement Together) Councils, which plan, carry out, and attend TRIAD COUNTY activities.



- Always take your time when making a financial decision.

- Prevent Identity Theft: Do not put your social security number on your checks or use it as identification. Have your local tag agency take your social security number off of your drivers license.
- Shred all documents with your information and cut up credit cards before they are discarded.
- Prevent mail theft: Take your mail to the local drop-off box or directly to the post office.
- Do not pay taxes or handling fees on a "free prize".
- Attend monthly SALT Council meetings = Seniors And Law enforcement Together.



- Have a plan and the tools to deploy it.
- CARRY BAIT KEYS
- JOIN SALT AND NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH
- Lock your doors, even when you're at home. Look out a peep-hole or window before opening the door to anyone
- Use a fanny pack to prevent pursesnatching
- 24 HOUR PARKINGLOTS ARE DANGERIOUS BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS
- CARRY A 9-1-1 CELL PHONE ON YOU
- Use a gel ink pen on personal checks
- LOCKED CAR DOORS ARE SAFER IN CRASHES
- BE FAMILIAR WITH YOUR HOME SECURITY ALARM'S "PANIC" FEATURE, TO ALERT POLICE IF YOU HAVE AN EMERGENCY
