

Rothesay Nursery School

Home School Agreement

During the Covid-19 pandemic, we are putting a new home school agreement in place. This is to protect your children/families and staff.

- Rothesay must be the only provision/setting your child is attending.
- If we contact you because your child is unwell, you must come and collect them immediately.
- To support social distancing, only one adult to bring your child to, and collect them from nursery.
- If you have to bring other children with you when dropping off or collecting, you must keep these children with you at all times.
- Parents will hand their child over to a member of staff at their allocated entry point and set time.
- All staff and children must wash their hands on entering the nursery.
- No toys or equipment may be brought into the school.
- Poor attendance will result in you losing your child's place.
- If anyone spits or bites, they will have to be kept at home until this pandemic is over.
- Children should be dressed in clean clothes daily and these must be able to be washed easily.
- Any child who needs to have their clothes changed will be dressed in nursery clothes.
- We will provide a reduced curriculum, which will focus on preparing your child for the transition to their next school.
- We will reduce the number of resources available in the classroom to limit the risk of cross contamination and keep everyone safe.
- Children will not be allowed to take nursery books home. Please keep book bags at home.
- Staff will endeavour to keep your child safe and we will be using the outdoor environment wherever possible.
- The provision we can offer will be subject to change due to factors which are outside our control.
- Activities to complete at home will still be available on the school website.
- **If a member of staff is taken ill for any reason – meaning they cannot attend work, then that class will not open, until the member of staff returns.**
- **If a child or staff member in that class is ill and has Covid-19 symptoms, the whole class, including children and staff will have to self-isolate for 14 days; unless a Covid-19 test is negative.**
- **If your child tests positive for Covid-19 they must have a proven negative test in order to return to nursery.**
- **If you refuse to have your child tested if they show symptoms or are in a group that is isolating, you will not be allowed back into school.**
