Discussion of Policies

- -Handbook applies to ALL band activities. Remember, you represent our program, the school and your community.
- -Expectations of Students: We expect you to practice!!! You will have recording assignments. We expect you to be positive and maintain positive at all times. We expect you to work together with everyone. Represent SJHS and the band program with the HIGHEST level of respect!
- -ATTENDANCE IS VITAL! Everyone is needed at EVERY practice! Monday Guard and Percussion 3:00-5:30. Tuesday and Thursday 3:00-5:30 Everyone!
- -Behavior: We have a new policy. If you have ISS, the first time is a warning. The second ISS will result in dismissal from the band program. Negativity on social media will NOT be tolerated. If you have an issue, please bring it to a band director so things don't get out of hand. We don't like drama. It's ok to be happy when others succeed. How our students and parents act is how our program is portrayed. We want that to always be positive.
- -Financial Responsibility: We are going to do more with invoicing to help remind parents when fees are due. You can NOT roll payments forward from year to year. ALL fees must be paid by SEPT 15th. There will be a \$25 charge applied for every month after this date. We set the payment plan so that we can pay bills that are due by certain dates. PLEASE talk to Mr. Joyce is you have an issue with the payment plan. Every year we have to pay for our show, props, transportation, adjunct staff, meals, repairs, supplies, new equipment (when possible), etc. These things add up very quickly. Around \$22,000 is the low end of what it takes the band program to "go" each year. Just like every other school fee, if they are not paid, student will not receive their report card and schedule for the following year and Senior's will not be able to walk until fees are paid.
- -Calendar: Everyone is required to attend band camp. Students must wear tennis shoes (no sandals or open-toed shoes of any kind). Students need a water jug with ice WATER! These are sold at sporting goods stores, walmart and even some dollar stores. HYDRATE HYDRATE Bring sunscreen,

sunglasses (if needed), hats, music....etc. Eat a healthy breakfast each morning so that you do not pass out or get sick. TRUST ME ON THIS! There will be 3 PT's before camp.
