This year we are continuing our scoring format as a **Modified Stableford System**. What this means is that you will be awarded your 100% handicap and shots will be adjusted on your card. You cannot take more than a bogey. Example – If I am playing a par 3 and I get an extra shot because of my handicap, I cannot take more than a 5. That 5 would get me 1 point for a bogey. Pars get you 2 points, birdies get you 3 points, and eagles get you 4 points. This system lets you pick up when you know you cannot score any points. Speed of play will also be quicker and you don't have to grind out every shot. The GCSAA Tournament uses this each year and everyone seems to have a great time. If you have questions, the Pro Shop will explain this at the start of the shotgun.

This year we also are coordinating this tournament with a fundraiser auction for the **Wee One Foundation**. This foundation raises money to assist golf course management professionals (or their dependents) who incur overwhelming expenses due to medical hardship without comprehensive insurance or adequate financial resources. Since its inception, the foundation has gifted over **\$ 700,000** to families in the golf industry. More information can be found at weeone.org.

I am requesting donations from Distributors and anyone for services and/or hard goods. Example donations might be restaurant certificates, major league baseball packages, anything that someone would love to have along with any hard goods that your company might sell or need.

Something new this year is we will be advertising what is in the auction on our **Hoosier GCSA website**. This will be updated as gifts are donated and the bids will be posted. The deadline for posting the bids will be **Sunday, May 17th**. The bid sheets will be posted at the tournament to give everyone one last time to bid. I hope all three associations take part in the bidding to raise as much money as we can for this fantastic foundation. If you receive the winning bid, you will be invoiced from the Wee One foundation, **so you don't have to pay at the tournament.**
