

## HIS MUSTANGS KICK HARD.

Capt. L. G. Taylor, Jr., Scathes  
Nazis in Allied Drive on Paris.

Capt. Lester G. Taylor, jr., 25, son of Mr. and Mrs. L. G. Taylor, 4431 Jarboe street, commands a group of Mustangs which strafed and dive-bombed the enemy in the Allied drive to Paris, the Eighth Air force has announced.

In seven days' operations, his fighter group claimed a toll of seven Nazi aircraft destroyed and three damaged; three bridges demolished by direct bomb-hits; six locomotives destroyed and seventeen damaged; thirty motor vehicles left blazing on highways, and the bombing of five marshalling yards leaving twenty-five railroad cars destroyed and 125 damaged.
