On Saturday, September 16, 2017, the Harrisburg Diocesan Charismatic Day of Renewal will be held at the Cardinal Keeler Center, 4800 Union Deposit Road in Harrisburg. The theme this year is "The Holy Spirit – Fountain of Grace." The event will take place from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM and the keynote speaker will be Rev. ## Shelter Shuffle 5K - September 23rd

The 13th annual Catholic Charities Shelter Shuffle 5K Run/Walk will take place on Saturday, September 23rd on the campus of the former Harrisburg State Hospital (across from the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg). Registration begins at 8:00 AM. The shuffle starts at 9:00 AM. The registration fee is \$20 per person if received on or before September 1st (\$25 per person if received after September 1st). Registration is free for participants who collect \$50 or more in sponsorships. All proceeds benefit the Interfaith Shelter for Homeless Families.

All participants who register by September 1st will receive a commemorative event shirt. Shirts will be available to participants who register after September 1st while supplies last. Cash prizes will be awarded for the top male and top female runners. Additional cash awards will be given if there is a new male and/or female course record. Other awards will be given to runners by age category. There will also be a door prize raffle for participants after the event.
