She helped Robin direct the Cedar Hills BC Acteens, Cedar Hill, TN as they sorted and hung some spring clothes. These young missionaries did Bible studies and shared testimony to Jesus their Savior. They also served with Linda in the warehouse.

First time on a mission journey Crestwood BC, Crestwood, KY were blessed as they experience God at work among the local missionaries. They served in ministry with assistance as they stocked the FC shop with spring clothes.

Early one Saturday morning we were sitting in the Sun Room enjoying God time and we heard a surprise knock on the kitchen door. As I turned the corner there was a familiar sweet lady standing at the door with a big smile...it warmed our hearts. She and friends from Ben Avon BC, Spartanburg, SC came up on a mission visit. Later the boy saw a pretty Bible on the shelf that he liked so, we began talking about Bibles and salvation came up...found out he is saved but needed to come back to God. I gave him a Bible and encouraged him to begin reading in John. Then his future wife got in on the conversation and we found that she is not yet a believer. Try to make a long story some shorter we had a brief pre-marriage session and witness. Pray for salvation and for pre marriage council for this couple.

Jesus said that the world will know that you are my disciples because of the love that you have for each other. Pray that the lost will be able to see that love between all believers, especially the missionaries of the Tri- City Area.
