



# Library Update

I hope everyone is enjoying this spring season and looking forward to summer! Here is a rundown of all the great things happening at Giles County Public Library in the next few months.

**Art in Action (partnership with the Giles Arts Council)** is going through May and the dates are May 4<sup>th</sup> and May 18<sup>th</sup>. These are classes taught by Patricia Hickman and other volunteers for free here at the library. They are for kids and adults on both days and the focus will be painting. Please call and sign up. We will take a break during the Summer and start back in August.

T’Kayah Mitchell, Program Coordinator, and Elizabeth Roller, Youth Services Librarian have been very busy planning our **Summer Reading Program**. Our summer reading theme is Camp Kindness with an emphasis on outdoor activities. This program will run for six weeks starting June 5. Each week will have a different theme and different activities to learn about **Togetherness, Building, Creating, Playing, Growing and Learning** for the programs in the library and with outreach programs at the Boys and Girls Club, Kidz Kamp at the Rec Center, Pulaski Elementary and Southside summer camps.

Each week will also have special programs such as **Bob Tarter’s Animalogy** program, **Ed May’s Puppet Theater**, **Mr. Bond and the Science Guys**, and **TWRA and Julie Phillips from the Solid Waste Department** for a community clean-up day as we do our annual **Creek Walk**. We are also partnering with **UT Southern** for a **Family Birdwatching Program** and with **Giles County Historical Society** for an evening of **Camp Story Telling**. **Tamara Moody** will be here to read one of her books and have someone to illustrate as she reads. She will also get the kids involved in writing their own poetry. There will be something for all ages, kids through adults, during the six weeks of summer reading. At the end, we will have a big summer reading party for all who participate with prizes, games, fun and food. So make sure you get yourself, your kids and grandkids signed up for a great summer reading with **Camp Kindness** and read all summer long!

The **SunDrop Fest** is happening on Saturday, June 10. The library activities will be located in the kid’s section on the square in front of Furniture World. Kids will be able to play with bubbles, participate in a SunDrop Chalk Art Contest, and play Life Size Board Games such as Jenga and Tic Tac Toe. Bring your kids for a fun filled afternoon and evening and enjoy all the activities, music and good food that the SunDrop Fest has to offer.

**Lemonade Day** is happening in our communities on May 12. Lemonade Day is a free, fun, experiential learning program that teaches youth how to start, own and operate their own business – a lemonade stand. All fifth graders in the county will have gone through this learning program at school. So if you see

a lemonade stand or several lemonade stands while you are out and about on Friday, May 12, please stop and help these awesome fifth graders with their businesses.

**Robert Bailey’s** newest legal thriller, **Rich Waters**, will be coming out June 20. This book goes back to Lake Guntersville, Alabama in the second book in the Jason Rich series. We have set aside the date of June 29<sup>th</sup> in our Summer Reading Calendar for an author event with Robert Bailey. So mark your calendars! He always brings a crowd.

Just as a reminder, if you have been using the OverDrive App to download E-books and Audio books from READS, it is going away as of May 1, 2023. You will need to download the Libby App to continue to use READS. If you need help with this, the library staff will be glad to help.

Summer brings lots of water activities such as boating. If you need a boating license, you can take the boating test at the library. We also have the study books for the boating test.

And don’t forget about **Kanopy**. **Kanopy PLUS** is a streaming service for library patrons that we joined several months ago. Our library patrons can stream a curated selection of movies and TV series for free in the Easy Watching category and all you need is your library card. To access Kanopy from our library, you will have to go to Kanopy on the internet and find our library. Then you will need to put in your library card number and PIN/password. You can stream Kanopy from a variety of platforms: Desktop, Apple TV, Phones (iOS and Android), tablets (iOS and Android), Chromecast, Samsung Smart TV, Roku, Fire TV, Fire Tablet, and Android TV. The movies and TV series change out periodically, so check in often to see what is new. We are excited to be able to offer this service and we hope you will take advantage of it!

The library has so many great resources. We hope you will take advantage of all the free resources and information that the library has to offer. We also have the best search engines. They are called librarians and they do a fantastic job helping our citizens navigate the book stacks to find books they want or like to read, offering computer help when needed and answering most any question you can throw at them.
