MASS READING REFLECTION

October 17, 2021
First Reading
Is 53:10-11
[The Servant of Yahweh]

This passage is taken from the fourth of the Servant Songs of Second Isaiah, which have already been encountered on Palm Sunday. (Consult the commentary there.) This part brings out the idea of Jesus in today's Gospel that the Church (you and I) is there to serve.

Christian service implies self-denial and sacrifice, giving of self, sharing not only money but also time and concern, to an extent even that it may hurt. Jesus has done so and that is why the Church applies this song to him and all of us, his followers in service of "the brethren."

Second Reading
Heb 4:14-16
[Jesus Our High Priest]

As already mentioned (see 27th Sunday), the author is writing to Hebrews, meaning Christians of Jewish (Hebrew) origin, He refers to the Jewish high priest, who entered the sanctuary of the Jerusalem temple time and again to offer a sacrifice to God, and says that now Jesus is our high priest, who entered the sanctuary of heaven to pray for us.

To be sure, he (Jesus) is man and knows what it means to be a weak human being. Hence, turn to him confidently in time of need!

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Theme: Being of Service

A song from the musical *Godspell* has these lines concerning Jesus of Nazareth: "See [know] him more clearly, love him more dearly, follow him more nearly." Millions have done so over the centuries and countless others are still doing so today; and all have found the key to a meaningful life. In the Catholic tradition we know of two life-styles in which Christians search for meaning and happiness.

One of them is marriage, which is the life-style of most people. Facing life together, they try to see the Lord Jesus more clearly, love him more dearly, and follow him more nearly through the good stewardship of all the beauty and goodness of life that God has bestowed upon them. The other life-style, for those who are called to it, is "celibacy for the sake of the kingdom." It is a life of renunciation not as an end in itself but for a life of discipleship.

If they are well understood, both life-styles should witness to the same Christian mystery, namely, God's kingdom of justice, love, and peace as already initiated in human history. Today's Scripture readings deal with the issue of life-style.
