- 1. Large waterfall flowing under a curved trestle Mike Shockey to design and build location has been decided
- 2. Have a downtown main street city scene group
- 3. Industrial area group
- 4. Rail yard location has been decided Rich and Nancy Parsons to design and build (construction crew will lay the track)
- 5. Viewing window of the internal construction to be decided at a later date group
- 6. Second town or several business buildings group
- 7. Old mine with N gauge track for ore carts location has been decided Jay Schmucker probable designer and builder
- 8. Layout will be set in the 1950's and early 1960's and to be "scale" as much as possible (not toy like)
- 9. Farming area Rich and Nancy Parsons to design and build
- 10. Orchard Rich and Nancy Parsons to design and build
- 11. Business buildings and industries can be named after past members to honor them
- 12. AC Gilbert factory location has been determined Jay Schmucker to build
- 13. Layout will have a conventional backup track power source details TBD
- 14. Decision needed on powering turnouts and location of controls
- 15. Tracks will be powered using Lionel Legacy Cab1L system donated by Jay Schmucker

April 23, 2016 Layout update

The new layout started with the removal of all of the old modular layout. The lockers that were incorporated into that layout were moved to their new position by the Beltline Layout. Spacers were made so the human "Mi-jack" crane can be rolled under the layout. Items that needed to be cut were performed outside. In the Mezzanine level, we soldered wires to the switches to eventually make them non-derailing.
