County and State fair summary:

- Opal K got 3rd with her rabbit, sold her meat pen at auction and got blue with her foods.
- Lauren M got reserve in scrapbooking, a blue award in vet science, and horse and cow went very well and dog didn't go so well.
- Rachel W got a reserve with her cow and grand champion MC at state fair.
- Kristen M got champion with both her cows.
- Emmett WB got reserve champion at state fair for electric and all his other projects got blue.
- Cora WB got blue with her foods exhibit, and champion with both her vet science and clothing exhibits which got 3rd and 4th at state fair. At county both Sam and Widget got 3rd in obedience and she got reserve in showmanship.
- Stella got a blue award for her dress, a red for vet science and champion with her electrics which got reserve grand champion at state fair. She got overall rabbit showmanship and got 7th overall Jr for state rabbit judging.
- Ellie C got overall high point dog showman.

- Kammi C did well in cow got reserve high point horse showman, and got grand champion Jr dog showman at state fair. Her recycled clothing got reserve at county and her vet science got a blue award, and her creative clothing got champion at county and 7th at state fair.
