Pool Hours and Rules

For everyone's safety, the pool rules are posted on the pool house doors. Please make sure to review the pool rules and make sure that your children know the rules as well. Please be respectful to all patrons at the pool.

Pool Hours: May 27, 2017 - Labor Day Monday September 4, 2017 Daily 9 am - 11 am Adult Swim Only – No children in pool or deck area. Daily 11 am - 9 pm Lifeguard on Duty

CHILDREN UNDER AGE 10 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT OR SITTER 15 OR OVER.

While the lifeguard is on duty, a swim break of 10 minutes per hour will be conducted. The break will be an adult only swim time.

The pool will have WI-FI capabilities.

POOL RULES

HOA of Colony Woods under contract with the pool Management has delegated responsibility and authority to the lifeguards. The lifeguards are there to enforce rules, regulations, maintenance, and cleanliness in and around the pool.

1. The sign-in system has been implemented to protect our property. All residents, their children, and guests must sign-in to be admitted to the pool.

2. Lifeguards will be in complete control of pool facilities during the scheduled operating period.

3. The lifeguards on duty have the authority to suspend or refuse admission to any member or guest for flagrant and/or repeated violation of the Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations of the Association. Such periods of suspension shall not exceed 24 hours. Further disciplinary suspension of up to 4 weeks may be imposed by the HOA. The Board has authorized the lifeguard to phone the police in the event a member or guest refuses to leave when asked or if the member or guest poses a danger to himself or others.

4. Lenexa Police are authorized to enter the pool premises at any time and exercise the same authority as they would in any public place.

5. Absolutely no glassware is allowed inside the pool area or pool grounds. Drinks must be in plastic or otherwise unbreakable/breakage resistant containers. No gum in the pool.

No smoking or vaping (City code) in the pool area. If you choose to smoke outside the fence to

the pool, please dispose of your cigarette butts in the trash.

6. Pick up after yourself. Recyclables should be placed in the marked recycling bin and trash in the trash bin.

7. Clothing and disposable diapers may damage or clog filters. No cutoff shorts or other clothing will be allowed as a substitute for a swimming suit. No disposable diapers not designed for use in the water are allowed and should be disposed of in the trash containers.

8. Persons unable to demonstrate to the lifeguards their ability to swim are not permitted in the deep end of the pool.

9. If a member or guest is asked to leave the pool, he must do so promptly. If he is chaperoning a younger person, that person must also leave. Remember, children under age 10 must be accompanied by an adult or babysitter over 15.

10. If a chaperone or babysitter leaves the pool for any reason, he must also take the person he is chaperoning with him.

11. The Pool may be closed at any time due to inclement weather (thunderstorms, etc.), when the temperature falls below 68 degrees, or in the case of filter breakdown or other operational difficulties. The pool will be promptly reopened upon abatement of bad weather. NO PERSON WILL USE THE POOL OR UNLOCK THE GATE UNLESS IT IS OFFICIALLY OPEN AND A LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY OR IT IS THE ADULTS ONLY SWIM TIME BETWEEN 9 & 11AM.

12. Members or guests may enter the cabana for a limited time to use the vending machine. Otherwise, only AUTHORIZED persons are permitted in the Cabana.

13. Only children may use the slide. Only one person is permitted on the slide and ladder at anytime. The slide must be used in a sitting position, facing forward, or lying down. No jumping or diving off the top of the slide is allowed. The lifeguard has the authority to terminate any dangerous activities on the slide at his or her discretion. No one may be in the slide area when people are using the slide.

14. Playing or standing on the rope in the deep end is not allowed.

15. The pool telephone is provided for the safety of all residents and guests but is for emergency purposes only.

16. All members are required to have guests sign in, including names and phone numbers for emergency purposes. Guests must be accompanied by a resident member.

17. An adult swim /children's rest period will be called at every hour for 10 minutes. Adult swim includes 18 years and older. Children resting on the deck may not place more than their feet in the water. They are not to be on the steps in the water.

18. Members are responsible for making the rules of the pool known to their guests and are responsible for any damages or acts of their guests.

19. Rules and regulations may be changed, altered or added to without notice if the HOA Board feels that such a change will result in a safer and/or better pool operation. The HOA Board will make an effort to post changes to the bulletin board promptly.
