## Steps to a successful tourney:

1. Call 250-374-4653 to set a date and start time for your group.
  - a. Discuss Golf & Food Options available
  - b. Maximum of 4 players/group, tee times are every 8 minutes
2. Mt Paul will send you an email or fax summarizing your tournament date and start time.
  - a. *Complete and Return the Confirmation Sheet with \$250 Deposit*
3. Keep in Contact with Mt Paul with updated numbers and requirements

Let your group know the courses expectations, everyone must have their own set of clubs, liquor regulations prohibit bringing personal alcohol to a licensed establishment, which means no personal alcohol on the property. Tell them to be at the course 40 minutes prior to their tee time.

30 Days Before- Contact Mt Paul and update them on any changes in number of players that you may have. Confirm your information in regards to date, start time, meal choice, any rental clubs or power carts you may require.

7 Days Before -Communicate final number of golfers and dinners to Mount Paul for the tournament. The group will be charged for the number of golf and food Committed to 7 days before the event. You will receive an invoice for the numbers you confirmed..

3 Days Before- If paid in full, your group is eligible for complimentary range balls 1 hour prior to tee off.

1 Day Before -Prior to the event drop off any signage, prizes or other special requirements needed.

Day of Event – All participants arrive 40 minutes prior to tee off

## Terms & Conditions

1. In order to secure your golf event a **deposit of \$250** is required.
2. You must confirm your final numbers for golf and food 7 days in advance; these are the numbers you will be charged for. Final payment is due in full for all golf and food based on numbers 7 days in advance.
3. This sheet must be signed, completed and faxed or emailed back to Mount Paul on or before deposit due date.
4. In order to receive complimentary small bucket for each competitor prior to tee off tournament must be paid in full 5 days in advance.
5. **NO PERSONAL ALCOHOL WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE PREMISES. COOLERS ARE NOT PERMITTED. ANY PERSONAL ALCOHOL WILL BE CONFISCATED. IF A REPEAT OFFENSE OCCURS YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FACILITY, NO REFUNDS ISSUED UNDER THESE CIRCUMSTANCES.**
6. Each player must have their own set of clubs. (club rentals are available @ \$12.00 a set)
7. You are expected to keep up with the group in front of you and expected to tee off on time. If not Mount Paul reserves the right to move your group(s) forward to get back on time. ( Tee times are in 8 minute intervals )
8. In climate weather – the golf portion of the tournament will be cancelled only if the course closes. At that time the golf portion will either be rescheduled, given rain checks or gift certificates given. The banquet portion of the event will proceed regardless of the weather.
9. Taxes are applied in all areas as prescribed by Revenue Canada and there will be a **mandatory 15% gratuity on any food or beverage that remains unpaid after day of play** unless other arrangements have been made.
