The top 2 teams from each regional competition receive free entry to the competition; however, they still need to register and complete all forms by February 28, 2025.
Travel assistance grant - optional - Due March 15, 202
Schools should bring one chaperone per gender you have attending the competition (ex. If you only bring a team of girls, you only need one woman chaperone; however if you bring a team of boys and girls, you need one woman and one man). Chaperone will stay in dorm rooms with their teams. Dorm buildings are gender specific.

The 1st place team from North Dakota will go on to the national NCF Envirothon

The ND Envirothon DOES NOT pay for airfare, passports, and misc travel expenses to and from the national competition.
