

Information for Indiana/Ohio Invitational Rodeo at New Castle

- Sunday, April 24:** **8 am: Cowboy Church**, Arena bleachers
 9 am: One long go - All JH events will run first; with the HS events to start after JH is completed.

Deadline for entries will be April 15 at 5 pm. NO entries will be accepted after that date. Draw out date is April 19, 2022. If you draw out AFTER that date, you MUST pay the entry fee that is due, unless you provide a medical release or vet release. Payment (**check or cash**) will be due at check-in! A portion of your entry fee will be used for a mandatory jackpot for each day. Once the position draw is completed it will be emailed to each contestant. It will also be posted on our website (inhsrodeo.com) and our Facebook page.

This rodeo will count as two separate rodeos for Indiana and Ohio HS and Ohio JH. However, this is the State Finals rodeo for Indiana JH, so it will be treated as one rodeo with points being allotted for two go rounds, an average, and bonus points (plus points being carried in to state finals from best ten season rodeos).

On Saturday, we will run slack starting at 9:30am and performance at 7pm with both JH and HS contestants. On Sunday, we will run one long go starting at 9am, except we will run **ALL of the JH contestants first**. By doing this, we will be able to start calculating the Indiana JH points for State Finals winners. The HS (both Indiana and Ohio) will start their competition after the JH is completed.

There will be a shoot on Saturday morning for both high school and junior high contestants. This will be the state finals shoot for Indiana contestants. The shoot will start at 8:00 am, at the Monroe Township Conservation Club, 2400 CR 700 S, Muncie, IN 47302. Contestants should meet Dill Whittymore by the arena and be ready to leave at 7:30 am.

Stalls are mandatory and only one horse per stall. Absolutely no tie-outs, tack and go only. Once entries have been received, we will assign stalls. Stall cost for the weekend is \$50, which includes one bag of shavings. Shavings will be available to purchase at \$9 per bag. You are expected to keep stalls picked during the weekend; however, when you leave the saddle club will strip the stalls.

Camping with electric is \$45 for the weekend and is first come, first serve. (There are 216 - 20 amp, 165 - 30 amp and 34 - 50 amp, so there should be plenty of camping.) There are water hookups available, but you may need to bring a splitter and long hose, as they are not all close. No ground fires will be allowed. If the Saddle Club catches anyone with a ground fire, there will be a \$200 fine. Fires will be allowed in raised fire pits. Shower facilities are available on the grounds.

There will be barrel and pole practice runs on Friday evening from 7-10 for \$5 per run. Poles will be from 7-8:30 pm; barrels will be 8:30-10 pm.

Ohio Members – Please do NOT pay the scholarship fund fee shown on the entry form, as this is for Indiana HS members only.
