HIGH POINT RULES

High Point awards based on **one horse/one rider combination**. If a tie, the Showmanship, then Halter class are the tiebreakers.

Overall High Points are the combined English and Western High Point Totals

High Point tabulation is a scale based on the number of horses in the class. 1 point given for entering a class if not placed in the class.

The following classes **including Halter Classes** will be counted for High Point Awards:

17 & Under: 1 or 2, 6, 10, 12, 15, 17, 19, 20, 22, 24, 29, 31, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 48, 50

18 & Over: 1 or 2, 7, 11, 12, 16, 17, 19, 20, 22, 25, 30, 31, 35, 36, 38, 40, 43, 48, 51

W/T/J Novice Rider: 1 or 2, 5, 9, 21, 28, 39, 47

W/T/J Open: 1 or 2, 4, 12, 22, 31, 40, 48

Novice Rider: 1 or 2, 5, 9, 14, 21, 23, 28, 33, 39, 41, 47, 49

***To Be Eligible for High Point: Must show in Showmanship and Halter**

GENERAL RULES

- **ALL MANAGEMENT DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**
- **NO REFUND WITHOUT VETERINARIAN DOCUMENTATION.**
- **ASTM/SEI HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR RIDERS 17 AND UNDER AND MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED ON NVHA GROUNDS. WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED**
- Boots, collared shirts, long sleeves and long pants are required in all events (show clothes optional).
- Lead Line is walk only – may not cross enter in any other class
- To qualify for Walk/Trot/Jog Open and Walk/Trot/Jog Novice Rider High Points – may not cross enter in canter/lope classes
- All Riders under 16 years of age must have adult supervision
- Management reserves the right to cancel, split or combine classes.
- Management or Judges Decision is final
- Trail Course may be ridden English or Western.
- Excessive schooling, inhumane treatment or unacceptable behavior by participants will be subject to review by show committee and may result in dismissal from the show grounds.
- Horses that are out of control will be excused from the arena.
- Stallion handlers must be 18 years or older.
- Age of riders as of January 1, 2018.
- Green Horse – First or second year showing in that division
- Novice Rider – Not to have won 5 blue ribbons in any show
