Question:

Where are euphoric cravings housed in the brain?

Answer

Short answer: basically, the root of cravings lies in the brain's rewards system. A network of neurons activate reward seeking behaviors. Just the mere sight of the desired drug or even being in the environment will activate the desire for Illicit drugs. Stimulation of this pleasure circuit can induce greater feelings of pleasure than natural functions.
