WHAT TO EXPECT

Our events are not slow paced, our days are long and they start early. We suggest everyone arrive at the track by 6:30 the day of the event, mandatory drivers meeting starts at 7am, and the track goes hooy at 8am. You will get around 2 hours of track time split up between 5 sessions each day. While you are on track you will be passing and getting passed by other cars. Passing is done in a controlled manor with the lead car being required to give a point to allow the passing car to ocertake. If you are new to the sport of performance driving you will be required to have an instructor in the car with you. The instructors will help you learn the ins and outs of driving on a racetrack. You need to have your car technical inspected within 30 days of the event, the link to the technical inspection is below. The only other thing you will need is a helmet. If you do not own a Snell 2005 (or newer) rated helmet you can either purchase one prior to the event or rent one of ours.

CONVERTIBLES:

- Convertibles are allowed but must have factory installed rollover protection or aftermarket roll bar. If you question your cars eligibility please call 903-243-4531 prior to registering.

HELMETS:

- Helmets are required for all sessions other than parade laps. Your helmet must be Snell2005 rated or newer.
- Many helmets are only DOT rated, these are not acceptable.
- If your helmet is Snell rated it will have a Snell sticker either on the back of the helmet or under the padding.
- If you do not have the proper helmet we will have them available to rent

TECHNICAL INSPECTION:

- All drivers must have their cars inspected within 30 days of the event.

PASSING:

- Passing is allowed but only after a point by from the lead car and only where designated.

GUESTS:

- Family and friends are welcome to come watch.

- Children are allowed as guests, however we ask that they remain under your supervision at all times. They will not be allowed to ride bikes or scooters. Children will be allowed in the garage area but they will not be allowed to enter the pit lane.
- Guests must be over the age of 16 to be outside the garage area on pit lane.... NO EXCEPTIONS

PASSENGERS:

- Only Edge Addicts certified instructors are allowed to take passengers on track
- VIP Passes are available for your guests to ride with an instructor during a hot session
- All passengers must be at least 18 years of age with proper identification.

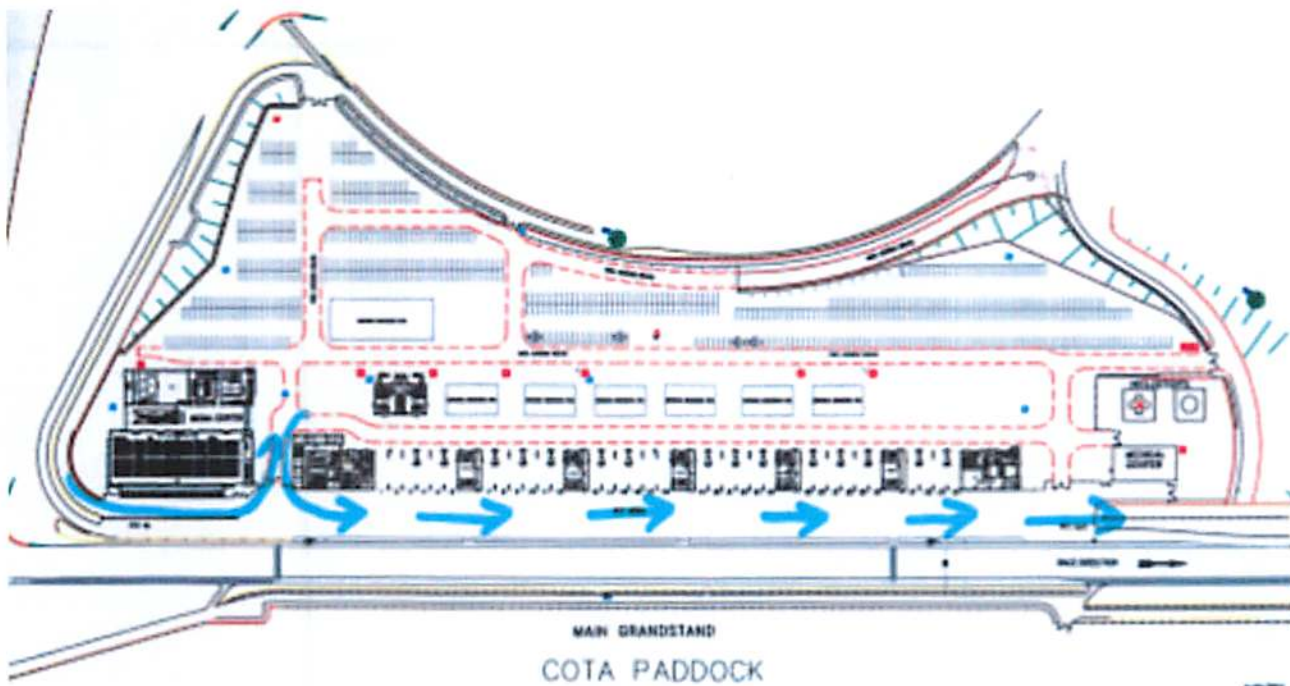
PETS:

- No pets are allowed.

GARAGE PARKING:

- Garage spaces are purchased on a first come first serve basis
- Each garage will house 4 cars, unless you purchased a full garage.
- Garage spaces will be assigned by staff and given with your registration material.
- If you would like to share a garage with friends we will do our best to coordinate. Please have garage mate names to us at least 10 days prior to the event.

PADDOCK AND PIT LANE:



- Paddock speed limit is 10mph, pit lane speed limit is 35.
- Pit lane is one direction only. Do not attempt to back up or turn around on pit lane.
- When entering the track stay inside the blend lane.
- Paddock parking: Please park all trailers neatly and out of the way. We would like to keep the area in front of the garages for event participant's vehicle parking.
- Do not cross any fire lane when ramps are down

TRACK DAMAGE:

- You are responsible for any track damage you cause
- If you believe you are leaking fluids get off the racing surface (safely)
- If you spill fluids in the paddock or garages quickly request assistance in cleaning up

TIRE RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Race tires are allowed in the advanced run groups
- Lower run groups are encouraged to run high rated street tires.

FUEL:

- Fuel available onsite at pumps
- You are allowed to bring your own fuel in approved containers
- NO fueling or idling in the garages

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU:

- Folding Chair
- Track bag to store personal items from car
- Sunscreen
- Healthy snacks and water
- Extra engine oil, brake fluid and power steering fluid
- Tire gauge and torque wrench for wheel lug bolts or nuts. If you don't have these Flamingo auto will be able to help.
- Window cleaner and paper towels.
- Blue painters tape to make car numbers.

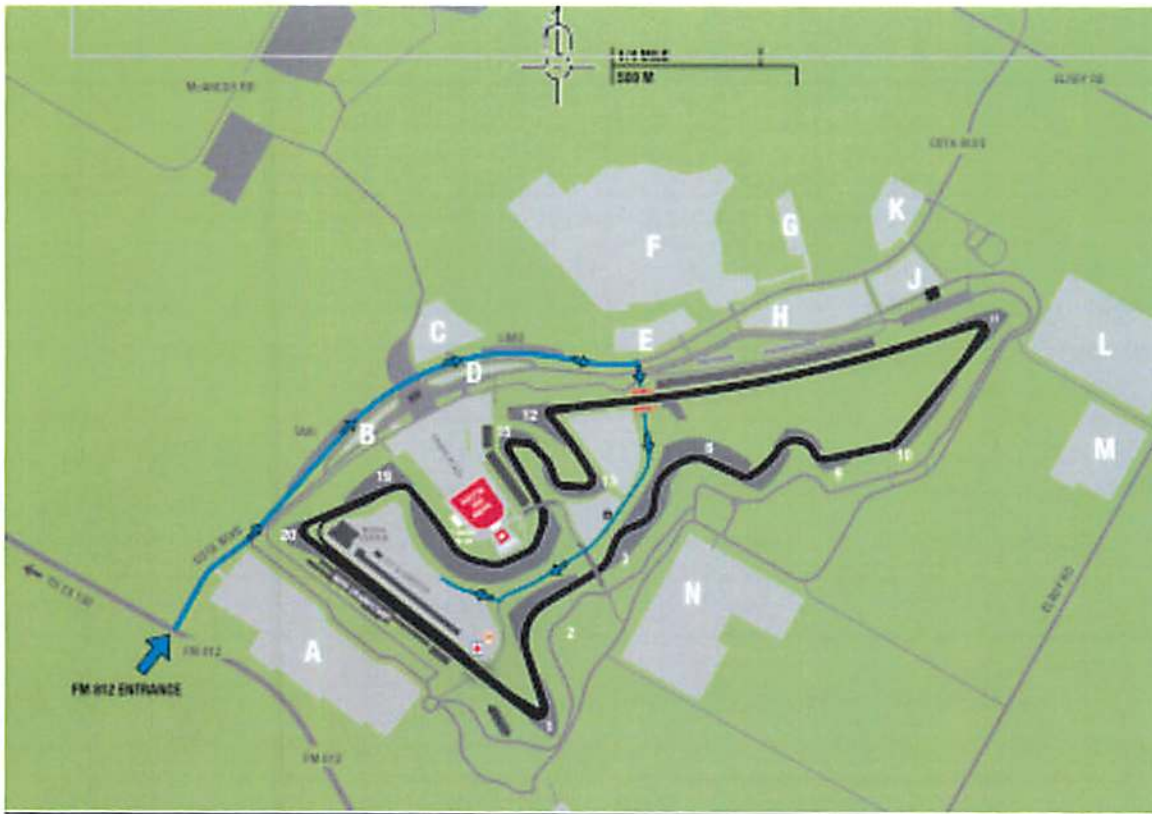
WHAT TO WEAR:

- Closed toe shoes are required for you and your guests. (No sandals will be allowed on the Pit Lane)
- Long pants are required (shorts are not allowed on the pit lane)
- Short or long sleeve shirt

CONCESSIONS:

- Breakfast will not be provided eat a light healthy breakfast prior to getting to the track
- Lunch and drinks will be available from 11 to 1:30 only.

FACILITY ENTRANCE:



- You will enter the track through tunnel two between turn 11 and 12 and proceed to the paddock
- All guests and participants must sign the waiver at the gate prior to entering the track

REGISTRATION AND UNLOAD:

- Registration (the night before the event) will be in garage 29. between 5 and 7 pm.
- Trailer and car unloading will be the night before the event between 5 and 7 pm
- Registration the morning of the event will be from 6:15 until 8 am in garage 29.

CAR PREP:

- Full tank of fuel (do not fuel in the garages)
- Numbers on side of car
- Remove all loose items from car including drivers floor mat
- Attach Tow hooks (you are responsible)
- Torque your wheels
- Check fluids
- Check Tire pressure
- Pay attention to pressure differences in your brake pedal

ON TRACK:

- If your car has a mechanical issue on track get off line, and stay in your car. DO NOT unhook seatbelts or remove your helmet. If you are near a corner worker station and can safely get over the guardrail you may.
- If you spin on track, pass in an unsafe manner, or go off track with all 4 wheels, you will be black-flagged.
- In a spin two feet in!
- Catch your first mistake and have an exit strategy before you need one.

- **Stay within your ability to correct for a mistake**
- **Key Fob in you pocket not car (keyless ignition)**

YOUR HEALTH AND WELL BEING:

- **Drink lots of water, do not wait until you are thirsty**
- **Rest and cool down between sessions**
