I write to you on behalf of all Parties in the above referenced action. Yesterday, the Plaintiffs and Defendants participated in mediation and, with the assistance of the Honorable Irma Raker, reached a tentative settlement. As is sometimes the case in class actions, the proposed settlement is more involved than simply the funding of a common fund for the benefit of the Class. Although the Parties have confidence that the proposed terms of settlement are fair, adequate and reasonable under Md. Rule 2-231, counsel for the Parties would like the opportunity to meet with Your Honor informally, in chambers, to update you on the protocol that we have agreed to and to seek the Court's guidance on how to proceed going forward. If at all possible, counsels' preference is to meet with Your Honor either later this week or next.
